

Presentation of Kidney Dialysis Machines at Hospital Escuela

November 16, 2007 a forty-five foot cargo container was loaded with the help of brethren from area congregations. Clothing, medical supplies, hospital beds, monitors, and other urgently needed items were shipped to Tegucigalpa, Honduras. The medical items in the container were to go to the public hospital El Escuela and the non - medical items were to be distributed by the churches of Christ in Honduras with our brother Erlindo Nuñez coordinating the activities. The container arrived and cleared Honduran customs. Here is a report and pictures of the presentation of the dialysis machines at El Escuela. Distribution of the other items shipped in the container continues with reports to follow.

“The equipment arrived in a good condition but the doctors were asking if there were anybody who could explain the most effective ways to use the machines. They would like a visiting brigade of physicians to come and discuss the use of these machines so treatments will be the most effective.
