Also we had visitors: Jeff Abrams, Ken Murphy, Mike Eubanks and David Myers. Like always our brothers shared with us good lessons; they were involved in all of our classes, not only in Kramatorsk, but in Konstantinovka and Kr. Shahtar. Our congregation always very glad to see our brothers and worship with them to God.

We had program for all congregation: "visit our brothers and sisters who did not worship with us". I asked each member of our congregation to be involved in this process, each of them have list with names, we encourage them to contact with those who did not attend church some sometime. It is big and difficult work, but we try to do it and praying that God help us.

We had birthday party, Each month church gets together for the tea, this is the time when we have fellowship with each other and say "Happy Birthday" to those who had it on that particular month.

I think church doing fine we set several goals for 2008 and now trying to go to that direction.

Our brothers brought some medicine and vitamins for Christians, all of them are thankful for that.

Our brothers brought \$220 for needy people and we helped some Christians: Mariy Emelynovna - \$40, Galina Stepanovna - \$80, Mariy Leontievna - \$40.

Bible classes.

Each Wednesday at 2:00 PM we have classes with adults christians and at 3:00 PM Oksana has classes with ABC's students. Usually we have total 18-24 visitors.

Each Sunday at 9:00 AM we still study book of Job now we on chapter 34. This class only for adults, Oksana has classes with the girls.

On our worship we have 24-30 people it is good number for this congregation. If somebody did not come we know reasons for that.

Visitations.

In church we have one lady she is paralyzed, her name is Mariy Leontievna. She can't walk without the help, and we know her about 9 years. She was baptized 7 years ago. It is difficult for her to worship with us, but we visit her and try to talk with her family . We brought some literature for her sons and grandchildren and hope she will help them to become Christians one day.

Humanitarians.

Most of Christians from Konstantinovka came to Kramatorsk and received clothes, it is good help for them. Also they take some for their families and friends. They told me that when they gave it away, they mentioned that it was from the Church of Christ.

Kindergarten.

Every month our church give the money what we received from brothers in America for children in this kindergarten. Now they have new director, after our discussion she convinced us that the help what they have been receiving during almost 8 year is still necessary for children. She is very polite and ask us to continue this help. We shared with them some coloring

Kr. Shahtar.

About 1 hour and 20 minutes from Kramarots to the village, during winter time road is not very good and it takes more time and strength to go there, but during winter time you can see beautiful nature and it helps you forgot about difficulties on the road.

Most of the time we have 3-4 on worship without us, it is small congregation and we glad that we have opportunity to worship with them.

From Kramatorsk we brought some clothes to the chrisitans there and people whom we know. In future we would like to do more in this direction. We will try to bring more clothes and put the invitation for them to come on their local board in the center of the village. So we will have the opportunity to tell them about Christ and give away some additional literature.

On our bible classes we are reading from the Bible, last time it was Preverbs and now it is book of Psalms. After that we discuss it. Now I think that for this congregation it is one of the best way to study Bible.

During our worship Oksana helps some children with English, also they stay with us and I ask them to read Bible and stay with us during worship.

On the way to Kr. Shahtar we try to visit one more place in the other village, may be one day one more church of Christ will be established there. We helped one lady with the wheelchair and also with the clothes and some books for her son. Her name is Tanya she has a son and a brother, we would like to study with them.
